PART II – ADMINISTRATION

The Minister

Broadly, the Minister is responsible for the preservation of the environment of Antigua and Barbuda with special interest being paid to human health. In execution of this duty he is expected to:

1. Collaborate with any other government ministers;
2. Facilitate the cooperation of significant institutions and the general populous;
3. Develop a policy that envelopes all aspects of environmental management;
4. Serve as a major enabler to the explicit administration of this act and;
5. Any other duty consistent with his functions as Minister.

Any of these powers may be delegated to the director except the power to make regulations as swt in section 109. These delecgations may be altered or revoked by the Minister at any time.

The Director

The Director shall be the head of the Environment Department.
